The Sand Hill Arroyo is a major watershed in the City of Las Cruces that flows from the Organ Mountains to the Doña Ana Drain. With recent improvements to the watershed by the construction of dams/ponds, the flood plain area was reduced, removing many residents from the flood zone.
